The Nome Police Department just started to use a computerized data base for arrests, the data we received did not provide number of village residents and the Nome Courts just started computerizing their records in June 2007. CINA stats are being compiled. As of Sept 30, 2007, there were 25 children in and out of home placement. Of these, 9 were on trial home visits, 6 were with non-relative foster families, 6 were with family foster, 22 are currently on the run, 2 are in institutions.
