

Death Reports for Federal Probates:

There is a difference between State and Federal Probates.

Federal land, or Native Allotments and Restricted Townsite Lots were deeded to Native Alaskans by the United States Department of the Interior. Kawerak, Inc., Land Management Services prepares a federal probate for this kind of land that any Bering Strait Region Tribe Member owned at the time of their passing.

The attached form is the “start” of filing a Death Report with the BIA. If the deceased owned a Native Allotment or Restricted Townsite Lot and was a tribe member of the Bering Strait Region, we will write a letter to the family to get the Federal Probate process started. **Land will NOT be transferred to the potential Heirs unless we file our Federal Probate.**
