

**EMERGENCY ORDER  
MANDATORY REQUIREMENT FOR KOYUK  
EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY  
March 23, 2020**

To prevent or slow the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) the City of Koyuk, Native Village of Koyuk and Koyuk Native Corporation (Tri-Council of Koyuk) has established the following guidelines for our residents:

1. All residents will be mandated to self-isolate for two weeks upon return to the community. It is recommended for residents to take your temperature with a thermometer two times a day and monitor for fever.
2. No large gatherings will be permitted in the community until further notice.
3. Residents are encouraged to limit visitation to other homes and no loitering in public places.
4. Residents are urged to limit unnecessary travel and only for Medical & Emergency Travel.
5. All intervillage travel into Koyuk is prohibited. If certain requests are needed, please call: Morris Nassuk at 412-3854
6. Residents should avoid going to the clinic if they are not sick.
7. Residents that have symptoms of cough and fever of 100.4 or higher must call the nurse triage line at 1-844-586-8773 or 443-6411 to make an appointment.


**COVID-19 Stability**
