The three entities stated above has come together to update the mandates to continue to help stop the spread of the COVID-19. We ask that you abide by all so we can continue to keep our community and its members healthy and safe from this virus.

1. Travel Status


- a. Travelers who would like to come to Shaktoolik from a "local area community"- Bering Straits Region- can do so without having to quarantine or get a virus test upon arrival, but only if the traveler informs the City of Shaktoolik immediately upon arrival or ahead of time. If the traveler does not inform the City of Shaktoolik of their presence, will be subject to a 14-day quarantine.
- b. Travelers coming back from Nome and Anchorage, or any other community besides those listed above can either go straight to a residence and shelter in place for 14 days. Or shorten the length of a shelter in place requirement to 7 days if you get a test 24 hours prior to arrival in Shaktoolik or go straight to our local clinic to get tested and retested 7 days after the fact. If the test comes back negative, then mandatory shelter in place is finished.
- c. Travel may be permitted upon approval by the City of Shaktoolik for the following:
Individuals with family ties to the community, essential workers, medical appointments and/or emergencies and outside personnel for any community emergencies provided they test negative prior to travel to Shaktoolik.

2. Public Gatherings Prohibited

- a. Indoor public events will be postponed or cancelled until further notice including local basketball tournaments, large meeting/gatherings with 100 or less people.

We are taking every effort to ensure the safety of each community member. This is a community wide effort to help prevent the spread of the COVID-19. Keep clean, disinfect surfaces, doorknobs, light switches, handles and anything that is touched regularly.




