EMERGENCY NOTICE

TO PREVENT OR SLOW SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

The City of Stebbins, Stebbins Community Association, and Stebbins Native Corporation has established the following guidelines and exceptions with limited ban for our residents:

Effective March 25, 2020 all non-medical air travel and inter-village travel will be prohibited from entering Stebbins for the next 30 days.

- 1.) All returning residents will be mandated to self-isolate for 2 weeks upon arriving into our community.
- 2.) No large gatherings, no than 10 people or public loitering should be permitting in the community until further notice.
- 3.) Residents are urged to limit unnecessary travel.
- 4.) Non-residents must request to the City of Stebbins before entering into the community.
- 5.) Residents should avoid going to the clinic to the clinic if they are not sick:
 - a) Residents who have symptoms of cough and fever of 100.4F or higher, must call the NSHC Nurse Triage line at 1-844-586-8773 or 443-6411 to make an appointment to get seen at our local clinic.
- 6.) Travel will be permitted for serious medical conditions or emergency medivacs.
 - a) If an emergency occurs in the community and additional outside assistance (EMT's) travel into the community will be permitted.
- 7.) With the acceptance of medical travel, if any individual(s) leaves the Saint Michael Island; they may not return to Stebbins until the 30 day travel restriction ends on April 25, 2020 or upon further notice.
- 8.) Freight, cargo, and mail services are still permitted.
- 9.) A 10pm curfew for all community residents will be implemented until further notice.
- 10.) Travel between Stebbins and Saint Michael will be prohibited from 12-midnight to 8am each day. Violation of this will lead to the impounding of the motorized vehicle with a \$250 fee.
